GRANNY SQUARE SCARF by Lisa Myers

The perfect way to mix and match Koigu mill ends or the remnants from all those pairs of socks.

MATERIALS:

Approx. 75 g (260 yds) of KPPM for borders

Approx. 50 g (175 yds) of assorted KPPPM scraps and mill ends for squares.

Crochet hook, US E

FINISHED SIZE: 6" x 48"

PATTERN:

Granny Square (make 32):

Using any color of KPPPM, ch4; join with sl st to form ring.

Rnd 1: Ch3; 2dc into ring; (ch2, 3dc into ring) 3x, ch2, join with sl st into top of ch3.

Rnd 2: Turn the work over. Ch3; 2dc into ch2 sp from Rnd 1; ch2, 3 dc into same ch2 sp; (ch2; into next ch2 sp from Rnd 1, work 3dc, ch2, and 3 more dc) 3x; ch2, join with sl st into top of ch3.

Rnd 3: Turn the work over. Ch3; 2dc into ch2 sp from Rnd 2; *ch2, (3dc into corner ch2 sp, ch2, 3dc into same corner ch2 sp), ch2, 3dc into next ch2 sp; rep from * twice more; ch2, (3dc into corner ch2 sp, ch2, 3dc into same corner ch2 sp), ch2, join with sl st into top of ch3. Cut yarn and fasten off.

Rnd 4: Join KPPM (CC) with sl st into any corner ch2 sp; ch2. 2dc into corner sp, ch2, 3dc into same corner sp; *(ch2, 3dc into next ch2 sp) twice, ch2, 3dc into corner sp, ch2, 3dc into corner sp; rep from * twice more; (ch2, 3dc into next ch2 sp) twice, ch2, join with sl st into top of first ch2.

Cut yarn and fasten off.

Assembly: Hold two squares together, right sides facing each other. Using KPPM, work sc through both pieces of fabric, working in back loops only. Continue to add 14 more squares one at a time.

Make a second strip of 16 squares, then join the two long strips down the center of the scarf.

Work 1 row sc around outer edge.

Weave in ends.
