

# TIGHTROPE legwarmers

## Materials

- 1 skein Dream In Color Classy (100% Superfine Merino; 250 yds/4oz). Shown in color 310- Petal Shower.
- US 5 (3.75mm) and US 7 (4.5mm) double pointed needles- or size needed to obtain gauge.
- 4- 3/4" buttons
- Stitch marker
- Darning Needle

## GAUGE

5 sts = 1" on larger needles  
in double seed stitch

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

12" long, 13" circumference

## ABBREVIATIONS

BO- bind off  
CO- cast on  
k- knit  
p- purl  
sl- slip  
sts- stitches

## Double Seed Stitch

Round 1 & 2- \*K1, P1 repeat from \*  
till end of round  
Round 3 & 4- \*P1, K1 repeat from \*  
till end of round  
Repeat rounds 1-4

## Make Buttonhole

Bring yarn to front, sl1, bring yarn to  
back, \*sl1, pss0\* repeat inbetween \*'s  
one more time (2 times total)

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## DIRECTIONS

- With larger needles CO 70 sts.
- Divide the sts evenly onto 4 needles (17, 17, 18, 18). Place marker to mark beginning of round. Join into a round being careful not to twist sts
- Rounds 1-4: Work in double seed stitch
- Round 5: Continue in established pattern, work 34 sts, make buttonhole, continue in established pattern until the end of the round
- Round 6: Work in established pattern to buttonhole, CO 2 sts using single cast on method, continue in established pattern to end of row
- Round 7 - 14: Continue in established pattern
- Round 15: Work as row 5
- Round 16: Work as row 6
- Round 17- 20: Continue in established pattern
- Round 21: Change to smaller needles and begin K2, P2 rib for 1 1/4"
- Change back to larger needles and begin double seed stitch. Work in double seed stitch for 10"
- BO loosely

## FINISHING

Sew buttons on ribbing to align with corresponding buttonholes. Weave in ends.
