

# Osier Mittens

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Approximately 52 inches around and 7 inches tall

## MATERIALS

- 1 skein of Swans Island Worsted (100% Certified Organic Merino) Shown in color Spring Green
- US #7 (4.5 mm) dpn
- US #9 (5.5 mm) dpn
- G crochet (4 mm) hook
- Tapestry needle
- Scrap yarn

## GAUGE

4.5 sts = 1 inch

## NOTE

There are two slip stitches located at beginning of needle one and at the end of needle two; created by slipping the stitches every other row.

The palm sides of mittens are worked in reverse stockinette.

## RIGHT-HAND MITTEN

Using waste yarn, provisionally CO 37 sts. Set up row: Divide stitches on smaller needles by placing 10 sts on needle one and 9 sts on needles two, three and four. Join being careful not to twist.

Cuff: Work in St st for 10 rows. P 1 rnd for turning ridge of hem. K 10 rows more. Remove provisional CO and replace open sts on larger needles. Fold hem with wrong sides together, hold larger needle behind smaller needle, and K tog 1 st from smaller needle with 1 st from larger needle. Rep around to close hem. Work patt rep chart and palm side 2 times.

Begin thumb shaping: Keeping in pattern, work to last 2 sts on needle two, pm, begin thumb chart. AT SAME TIME work patt rep chart, palm side and thumb chart. Work patt rep to beginning of thumb sts on needle two. Using tapestry needle place all 12 thumb sts on scrap yarn. CO 2 sts (new side slipped sts). Work palm side. Work patt rep and palm side for 3 in. or until desired length
